Buddy Committee: Buddies have the opportunity to share God's love one-on-one with prom guests. Each prom guest will be assigned a Buddy for the event who will spend the evening dancing, eating, enjoying activities, and providing assistance as needed with a guest with special needs. Buddies must be at least 16 years old, mature, compassionate, bighearted, fun-loving, and willing to help their assigned guest have the night of his or her life! Buddies must also attend a brief, but important, training session at FPC later this month.
