Are infants to be baptized? (The Heidelberg Catechism, 4.074)

Yes, infants, as well as their parents, are included in the covenant and belong to the people of God. Since both redemption from sin through the blood of Christ and the gift of faith from the Holy Spirit are promised to these children no less than to their parents, infants are also by baptism, a sign of the covenant, to be incorporated into the Christian church and distinguished from the children of unbelievers. This was done in the Old Covenant by circumcision. In the New Covenant baptism has been instituted to take its place.

How does God use our financial generosity towards the church? Consider First Presence: First Presence is our annual community service day where we seek to mobilize the whole church to get involved in multiple community service projects. This year we contributed over \$4000 on six different projects. We participated in Eastside Elementary's Fall Festival, sponsoring students who ordinarily could not afford tickets to this event, gave out candy and assisted with games. We helped with pick-up and delivery of furniture and appliances for needy residents in our community in partnership with Faith in Action. We provided fruit and cookie baskets for our Emergency Room, Fire and Police Departments (700+ people) to thank them for their service to our community. Old picnic benches and neon lights were replaced at the SHARE House, stairs were painted and a parking lot was pressure washed and demarcated. We sang to residents at Grace Assisted Living and served and prayed with over 100 people at The Pantry, a local food bank.
