Through the generous living and giving of FPC friends and family, First Kids ministry is able to provide quality instruction, resources and numerous opportunities for outreach and fellowship to children and families to know and grow in Christ Jesus. Curriculum and supplies, including those used throughout all CE departments, necessitate quite a bit of funding for regular Sunday and Wednesday programming. In addition, children's ministry maintains a safe, inviting and attractive environment for infants through grade five that is shared five days a week with Seeds of Faith Preschool. Our annual Egg Hunt and Harvest Festival encourage outreach to children and families in the community with events that foster faith growth and family fun. Daily attendance of over 225 during Vacation Bible School, plus a fun family night activity, made for a great week of ministry to children. At least five other churches benefitted from a recycling of VBS decorations provided by our church this summer. Blessed by the time and talents of our volunteers, children's ministry continues to be a strong presence at FPC.
